

How to Host a Canadian Aquatic Rehab Course at your Facility:

Fees:

- Instructor fee: \$2250 per day plus travel expenses (airfare, hotel, transfers/car)
- Maximum registrants 16 (teaching ratio 1:16).

Canadian Aquatic Rehab Provides:

- 8 hours of Instruction per day, content tailored to program needs and course participants
 - Lecture presentations, 2 -4 hours per day
 - In-pool practice 4-6 hours per day
- Participant handouts and Certificates
- Advertising the course, if requested, on the CAR website and newsletters.
- Optional patient consultation as arranged by Facility; to enhance learning and apply concepts

Host Responsibilities:

- Registration management, payment collection
- Set your course fees (recommended \$400 per day).
- Payment of Instructor's fee within 30 days of course completion
- Travel and hotel can be booked by CAR or Facility
- Advertising and promotion with the help of CAR
- Provide pool and changerooms.
- Provide a classroom or gym with chairs, tables, and AV equipment (screen, projector).
- Optional arrangement for refreshments
- Optional - arrange for patient demonstration -assessment, treatment.

Cancellation

- Courses can be canceled at no cost up to 4 weeks beforehand.
- If minimum # of registrants, to cover course costs, is not reached 4 weeks prior, the host can either:
 1. Continue with the course and cover any outstanding costs not covered by registrant's fees.
 2. Cancel the course at no cost.
